From the Principal

Supporting teenage friendships

As a parent, we are a sounding board for our kids about life in general but when friendships are under pressure, it is important that we help them manage to negotiate how to move forward in the relationship.

Listen to them

It is important to listen to them, without any judgement or suggestions to fix things. Listen to the entire story without interruption. Make sure you completely understand their perception of what has happened. It is important to remember that this is their side of the story and there will always be another side to the story.

Consider your response

How you respond is key. If you react too strongly, it might exacerbate the situation. Try not to criticise the others involved as it may be that the friendship can be restored. Make sure you remain calm. Make sure you let them know that you trust they can handle this situation and you will be there for them. Ensure they know you love them unconditionally.

Reset to normal

Family routines are a comfort and help teens to calm and not dwell on their concerns. Home is usually their happy place, but they need to keep everything in their life on track ... go to sport training, get eight hours sleep and walk the dog as usual. If their routine is normal, it will help them de-stress. If possible, try to encourage your daughter to stay off social media until things have been resolved.

Pause

It might be tempting to ring the parents of other children or rush to school and that is a perfectly normal response. It might be best to sleep on it first before acting. When we rush in to solve the problem, sometimes you disempower your daughter and take away their opportunity to grow. We want them to know they are capable and empowered to solve problems.

Problem solve

Your daughter needs to be part of the solution. Sometimes it might be the right time to make a break with a friendship that is not working for them. Sometimes the teens just need to share their emotions and hurts with each other, and the friendship can be restored. For your daughter, it is important that they surround themselves with friends that empower them, who make them feel good about themselves and will let them be themselves.

At Stella, we want the girls to be able to move through adolescence with all the support they need. We work in pastoral care and year meetings to help provide the skills the girls need to negotiate the teen years. We want you to know that we are working alongside you as parents and carers to help your daughters grow. Speak to your Head of Year or the counsellors if you need some additional help with supporting your daughter.

Sailing Towards World Champs

Congratulations to Violette R, in Year 10, who competed in the J24 State Championships on Sydney Harbour last Friday to Sunday. In the Youth Challenge on Friday, Violette helped her team secure second place overall. An outstanding achievement!

Saturday's highlight was a thrilling victory in the third race. Sunday tested their mettle with cold, windy and rainy conditions. Violette admitted, "Being up on the bow the whole time was pretty harrowing, to be honest". They were very close to placing second overall until "the last 30 metres of the race when a ferry stole the wind, allowing two boats to overtake".

Despite the setback, her team claimed fourth place overall in the State Championships.
